



Proposal: Restorative Practice Coaches Program for Positive School Community Building

I. Executive Summary:

The ESSDACK Resilience Team presents a unique opportunity for educators to embark on a transformative journey through our Restorative Practice Coaches Program. This specialized initiative is meticulously designed to empower educators in creating a positive and inclusive school community. Over a three-day in-person workshop, participants will immerse themselves in restorative principles and practices, gaining practical skills to foster strong connections within the educational ecosystem.

II. Objectives:

The primary objectives of the Restorative Practice Coaches Program are as follows:

- **Empowerment:** Equip educators with the necessary knowledge and skills to build robust connections with students, staff, and families.
- **Conflict Resolution:** Provide practical strategies for proactively addressing conflicts, promoting healing, and fostering repair within the school community.

- Implementation of Restorative Circles: Guide participants in the effective use of restorative circles, academic circles, and community circles to enhance empathy, accountability, and discipline.
- Year-Long Cohort Program: Establish a comprehensive year-long cohort program, featuring face-to-face summer training sessions and daily, in-house expert conversations during the school year, supporting ongoing professional development in trauma-informed practices.

- Cohort Collaboration: Joining the 2024 - 2025 cohort group enables the formation of a team of coaches and trainers, fostering collaboration and ensuring the development of skilled individuals ready to implement restorative practices.
