For March 2024, Education fund revenues were \$5.0 million and Education fund expenditures totaled \$11.5 million; expenditures exceeded revenues by \$6.5 million. The Operations and Maintenance fund revenues were \$9,024 and expenditures were \$1.9 million; expenditures exceeded revenues by \$1.9 million.

For the Investment Balances Report, as of March 31, 2024, the District had a combined cash balance of \$60.5 million in the bank for all funds. For the operating funds only (ED, O&M, Transportation, & Working Cash), total cash in the bank was \$15.9 million. Total investments are \$100.1 million. YTD earned interest on all cash accounts for the month was just under \$3.0 million. The interest rate on all cash accounts on March 31st was 2.5% or 250 basis points. The total balance of cash and investments for all funds as of March 31st, 2024, was \$160.6 million. Again, for operating funds only, the balance was \$15.9 million. The district also shows recorded County sales tax proceeds received during the month of March as \$1.33 million for the December collection period. Total collections of just over \$53.6 million.
